Babies who were cared for in the NICU may have special needs due to conditions which they experienced before birth, during birth, or during the newborn period. At the Regional Neonatal Follow-Up Program, we follow babies who MAY be at risk for developmental, speech, and/or growth delays. These babies include, but are not limited to those born prematurely, with a congenital malformation, as a result of a difficult delivery or were exposed to drugs or alcohol before birth.

At their neonatal follow-up visits, your baby will have periodic developmental assessments to identify and address any delays or issues resulting from their complicated course before or after birth.

As a supplement to your pediatric care, we help coordinate additional services that your baby may need in order to give them their best chance to attain optimal development.

All findings will be discussed with you and a copy of the evaluation will be sent to your pediatrician.
